Mural Recognition Opportunities



Main Stone – \$2,000 “From tiny steps to towering dreams, each year adds a stone to the path of a life”

The central anchor of the mural, honoring those whose major contributions lay the foundation for the Child Care House.



Stepping Stones – \$1,000

Each stone marks a child's milestone, together forming a path that reflects Mapleton's investment in its children.



Baby Fawn - \$750

A symbol of care, innocence, and new beginnings, representing the early stages of growth that every child experiences.



Boulder - \$500

A marker of strength and stability, recognizing those who help create a steady foundation for Mapleton's families.



Lily pad - \$250

Each Lily pad honors donors whose smaller contributions are essential to the community's larger picture.
